SMALLEST BABY SURVIVES AT 10 OUNCES

A baby girl born after just under 22 weeks in the womb—among the shortest gestations periods know for a live birth—was born in Florida on Oct. 24th, 06. Amillia Taylor, who weighted less than 10 ounces (283 grams), has been sent home after 4 months in a Florida hospital. Doctors say she is the first baby know to have survived after a gestation of fewer than 23 weeks. But full term births usually come after 37-40 weeks. Amillia was just 9 1/2 inches longer and weighed less than 10 ounces when she was delivered by cesarean section. She now weighs 5 lbs. Amil-

THE INCREDIBLE AMERICAN SOLDIER

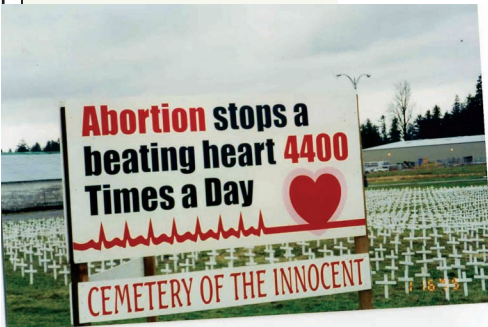
