# New Health Care Bill to include Unrestricted Abortion

**National Right to Life Calling for Action to Stop Abortion in Congress' Health Care Plans**



**Washington, DC (LifeNews.com)** -- A top pro-life group is calling for pro-life advocates to contact their members of the House and Senate and urge that abortion specifically be excluded from any health care plan it approves. The National Right to Life Committee says three bills advancing in Congress pose a threat to cover abortions or force funding of them with taxpayer funds unless Congress adopts language saying abortion coverage is now allowed. So far, two massive health care bills have been unveiled, one in the Senate and one in the House. The full House is expected to vote on its version of

the bill at the end of July. Senate floor action could occur shortly thereafter. "These two bills pose one of the greatest threats to pro-life policies since the Supreme Court handed down its Roe v. Wade ruling legalizing abortion in 1973," Douglas Johnson, legislative director for Right to Life, told LifeNews.com on Wednesday. "These bills contain multiple provisions that would result in federally mandated insurance coverage of abortion on demand, with massive federal subsidies, as well as mandated creation of many new abortion clinics and the nullification of at least some state limitations on abortion." Johnson added, "The pro-abortion movement sees federal 'health care reform' legislation as a golden opportunity to force-feed abortion into every nook and cranny of the health-care delivery system. Their goal, as they sometimes put it, is to 'mainstream' abortion. If Obama and his allies succeed, the result will be a very large increase in the number of abortions performed in America." Within hours of the vandalism, calls were coming in to our office asking if we knew anything. A police report was made and a press release was sent out to the media. # Dr. George Tiller Killed While in Church


## Slain abortion doctor George Tiller's clinic to close

Tiller had been the only abortion provider in Wichita, Kan., and his family's decision to close the facility leaves only two other clinics in the country that perform late-term abortions.

Reporting from Wichita, Kan. -- A long, difficult chapter in the struggle over legalized abortion came to an end today, when the family of slain physician George Tiller announced this morning that it would permanently close his Wichita abortion clinic, Women's Health Care Services.

Tiller, 67, was shot to death in the vestibule of his Lutheran church on May 31, where he served as an usher.



The shutting of his clinic means there are no abortion providers left in the Wichita area, and only two other clinics in the country that perform late-term abortions, Tiller's specialty.

In a statement released by attorneys Dan Monnat and Lee Thompson, Tiller's wife, Jeanne, and their four adult children said that the family was "ceasing operation of the clinic and any involvement by family members in any other similar clinic."

*This is an excerpt from the local paper in Wichita, Kansas. Take note of the last paragraph where his family says this is a legacy that will never die! Quite ironic*

*We are proud of the service and courage shown by our husband and father and know that women's healthcare needs have been met because of his dedication and service," the family said in the statement. "That is a legacy that will never die. The family will honor Dr. Tiller's memory through private charitable activities."*

**George Tiller claims to have done over 60,000 abortions. He believed in abortion and advertised all over America to get business for late term abortions. He started performing in 1974. He has traveled the world to promote his services and has made hundreds of thousands of dollars. He was arrogant and open about the thousands of babies he elected to kill in a cruel and painful procedure.**

## Lynden Human Life Purchases Seven Foot Granite Angel



After more than a decade of dreaming about angels holding babies to signify the over 50 million babies that have died to abortion, an angel has been found and is being made for our mission. 


