

Our only paid staff is our part time case-manager & office assistant and our house-manager who is compensated by rent free apartment & pd. utilities.



Lynden Human Life Installs Seven Foot Granite Angel



After more than a decade of dreaming about angels holding babies to signify the over 50 million babies that have died to abortion, an angel has been found and has been made for our mission. The marble angel stands five feet tall and has a two foot pedestal along with the inscription below, detailing the memory of all those who have died to abortion. We are paying less than half of what was expected from a long time memorial fund!

The Monumenta Cemetery board of directors has allowed us to set up this monument in the Lynden cemetery. We have graciously been donated two plots along the East boundry. Bodies Pre-cast has stepped in and is supplying us with a pre-made 8X8 concrete slab. Scholtens Euipment will donate a lift to place the angel on the pedestal. A bench will be set in front of the angel for visitors to view the monument.
