I'm Karlie Lodjic and I'm the president of the WWU Students for Life club. This year we have worked to take pro-life action in five areas: public policy, industry, supportive services for young mothers, education, and responding to pro-abortion activity. Spring quarter, we did a lot of work on campus with the last three of these areas. We set up a table at WWU to have students write encouraging notes to their pregnant and parenting peers for Mother's Day, and had pregnancy resources and baby clothes to distribute if needed. We also had two informational tables, one about the effects of Roe vs Wade and one about the dangerous side effects of abortion. Our club began leaving roses by and on the Planned Parenthood club table they host almost every Friday with information about quitting the abortion industry and a note that stated the rose represents 6,180 babies aborted by Planned Parenthood (PP) weekly in the United States. We wrote pro-life chalk messages in Red Square that included info on post-abortive recovery programs and pregnancy resources. This was mostly washed away by two students who refused to listen to what we had to say and insisted all anti-abortion resources are bad. We also stood outside Planned Parenthood on several abortion days with pro-life signs including pregnancy resources, and a woman insisted that Planned Parenthood should be our friend. Pro-Abortion Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy Announces His Retirement
